The Fund provides emergency financial assistance to eligible Greene County veterans. Monies from the Fund can be used to pay for both health-related expenses, like health insurance premiums, co-pays, coinsurance, and deductibles, and for household expenses, like rent, utility payments, and transportation. Additionally, our staff can help identify other resources that may be available to you.
